Hostess Committee Update

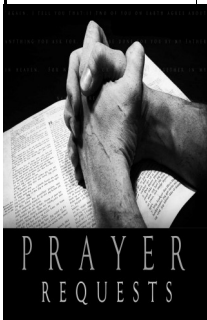
Beginning with the 2015-16 church year, the Hostess/Hospitality Committee will no longer be responsible for coordinating or hosting bridal or baby showers.

Just a few weeks from now our mission team will leave for Honduras (Oct. 12). They will leave Hamlet in the middle of the night for an early flight from Raleigh and will arrive in Tegucigalpa at mid day. At the airport in Honduras, they will be met by Mike and Ginger Greene who are the full-time missionaries supported by N.C. Baptist Men. The team will drive south to the town of Choluteca to the mission house where they will be housed for the next five days. Early the next morning (Oct. 13) they will begin work building a house for a needy family in a nearby village. On Sunday, Oct. 18, they will worship in the village where they have been working. Pastor Chris may preach the sermon. The team will arrive back in Hamlet late on the 20th.
